According to the Statewide Integrated Traffic Records System, e-bike injury collisions increased from just 184 in 2018 to more than 3,400 in 2023. Hospitals across the state are also reporting sharp spikes in trauma cases involving young riders, including head injuries and internal damage.

**Staying Safe on an E-Bike
Riders can reduce their risks by:**

- Wearing a properly fitted helmet at all times
- Following California’s e-bike class rules and speed limits
- Using lights, reflectors, and high-visibility gear—especially at night
- Riding defensively and avoiding excessive speeds in traffic or crowded areas
- Keeping brakes, tires, and batteries in top condition through regular maintenance

What to Do After a Hit-and-Run Accident

Unfortunately, not every driver shares the road responsibly. If you’re struck by a car while riding your bike and the driver flees the scene, take these steps immediately:

- Move to a safe location and call 911 for medical and police assistance.
- Gather as much information as possible about the vehicle—make, model, color, license plate, and location of the crash.
- Look for witnesses who can provide statements or video evidence.
